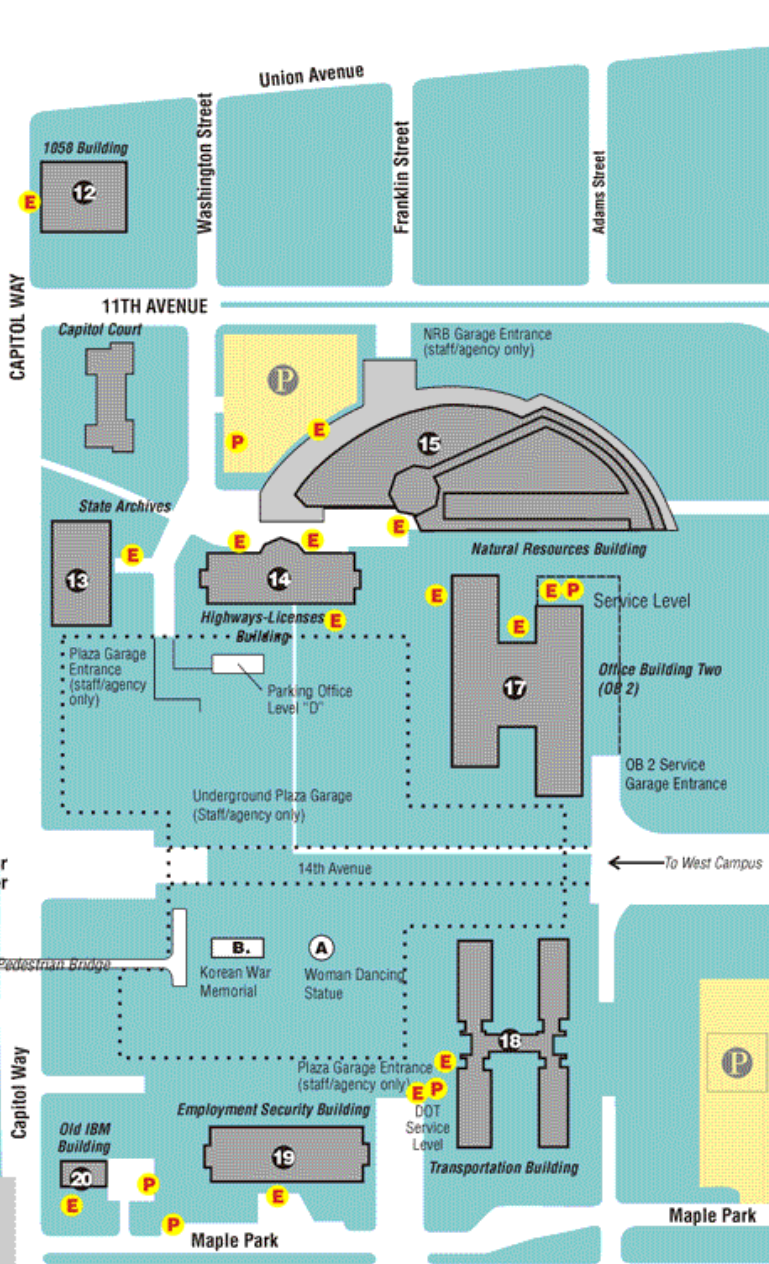

Directions to the Campus

Via Interstate 5
Take exit 105
To proceed to the **West Campus**, stay in the center lanes exiting the tunnel at Capitol Way.
To proceed to the **East Campus**, (north of 14th Avenue) take the right lane to Jefferson Street, then turn left on 11th Avenue, and another left on Washington Street. Visitor parking is on your left.
To proceed to the **East Campus**, (south of 14th Avenue) move to the left lane and turn left on Jefferson Street, and look for the visitor parking signs.
Tour and School Buses:
Buses may unload and reload passengers on the Capitol Campus at the Winged Victory statue (at the junction of the North and South Diagonals). Buses should then park in the designated areas near Jefferson Street.
