It is time to renew your direct patient-provider primary health care services registration with the Office of the Insurance Commissioner.

You are currently registered as a provider offering direct patient-provider primary health care services in Washington. In order to continue to offer these services, Chapter 48.150 RCW requires that must renew your registration by submitting the annual registration survey.

Please complete this survey by **Tuesday, October 1, 2019**. The survey is open and available for you to complete and submit from now until 11:59 pm on October 1, 2019. The registration survey must be completed in order for you to continue offering direct patient-provider primary health care services. Your registrations **will not** be renewed if you do not submit your completed survey timely and you cannot lawfully offer direct patient-provider primary health care services until you re-register with the Office of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC). If you continue to offer direct patient-provider primary health care services without being registered, you will be in violation of Washington law and subject to enforcement, including but not limited to a Cease and Desist and a fine for transacting insurance without a license.
