SUBJECT: Adjuster Continuing Education Rulemaking Survey

TO: Resident Independent and Public Adjuster Business Entities

The Administrative Procedures Act (<u>RCW 34.05</u>) and the Regulatory Fairness Act (<u>RCW 19.85</u>) requires the Office of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC) to consider the impacts of its rulemaking for small businesses. The OIC has initiated rulemaking pertaining to <u>adjuster continuing education</u> requirements (<u>R 2021-03</u>). Therefore, pursuant to <u>RCW 48.02.060(3)</u>, Insurance Commissioner Mike Kreidler hereby directs each authorized resident independent and public adjuster business entity to provide certain information regarding their continuing education requirements through the continuing education survey:
