An examination of the financial condition of **THE WHITWORTH FOUNDATION** (TWF) as of December 31, 2004, was conducted by examiners of the Washington State Office of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC). TWF holds a Washington certificate of exemption to issue charitable gift annuities. 
CONCLUSIONS

Dear Mr. Odiorne,

We received the Financial Examination Report of the Whitworth Foundation as of December 31, 2004, issued by your office.

We have read the report and have the following comments:

- 1) Page 3, Affiliated Companies. The second sentence should read that college was founded in 1890 and incorporated the same year, not 1972. The Whitworth Foundation was incorporated in 1972, but the college was incorporated on the earlier date.
- 2) Page 3, under the Management and Control section, Board of Directors (BOD), the document indicates that the names listed were the directors as of December 31, 2004; however, not all those names were active directors as of that date. All the names listed belong to individuals who were directors at some point during the period of examination, 2000 to 2004, but the directors as of December 12, 2004 were only the following members:
