



prehearing conference in this matter, wherein, among other activities, it was agreed by the parties that the hearing herein should be scheduled to commence on February 9, 2009.

Subsequently, a second prehearing conference was held in this matter on January 26, 2009, at the request of the Insurance Commissioner. The Insurance Commissioner, appearing by and through Alan Michael Singer, Staff Attorney in his Legal Affairs Division, advised that the parties were making some progress in negotiations which may result in settlement of this matter and therefore asked that the hearing be continued for 60 days, until April 15, 2009. John A. Hanley d/b/a Jurisco, appearing by and through his attorney, Mr. DeLeo, agreed to this requested continuance and new hearing date, confirming that the parties were engaged in negotiations and that a settlement might be able to be reached. Based upon this information, the undersigned agreed to continue the hearing and indicated that she should be contacted should the parties believe that she might be able to assist in any discovery or other issues which could help in their negotiations.

Based upon the above activity, and for good cause shown,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the hearing in this matter is continued until **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 15, 2009**, in the Office of the Insurance Commissioner, 5000 Capitol Blvd., Tumwater, Washington, and shall continue on succeeding days until terminated.
