
By letter dated July 14, 2008 and filed on July 15, Farmers New World Life Insurance Company (Farmers New World Life), by and through Jerry Kindinger, Esq. of Ryan, Swanson & Cleveland PLLC of Seattle, filed a Request for Hearing objecting to the Office of the Insurance Commissioner's (OIC) certified Report of Examination as of December 31, 2006. During that time, because the OIC maintained that said financial exam report was final and ready to be made public, Farmers was intending to file for a motion for a temporary restraining order prohibiting publication on July 14, 2008, and later agreed to file its motion instead on August 15, 2008. However, no such motion was filed.

By letter dated August 5, 2008, and confirmed by an August 8, 2008, telephone message with Wendy Galloway, Paralegal to the undersigned, Farmers New World Life advised the undersigned that it was thereby withdrawing its Request for Hearing in this matter.

Based upon the above activity:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that this proceeding, Docket No. 08-0115, is hereby terminated with prejudice.
