



By letter dated July 16, 2008 and filed on July 17, Farmers Insurance Company of Washington (Farmers), by and through Jerry Kindinger, Esq. of Ryan, Swanson & Cleveland PLLC of Seattle, filed a Request for Hearing objecting to the Office of the Insurance Commissioner's (OIC) certified Report of Examination as of December 31, 2006. During that time, because the OIC maintained that said financial exam report was final and ready to be made public, Farmers was intending to file for a motion for a temporary restraining order prohibiting publication on July 14, 2008, and later agreed to file its motion instead on August 15, 2008. However, no such motion was filed.

By a July 29, 2008, telephone call to Wendy Galloway, Paralegal to the undersigned, and confirmed by letter dated July 31, 2008, Farmers advised the undersigned that it had withdrawn its Request for Hearing in this matter.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that this proceeding, Docket No. 08-0122, is hereby terminated with prejudice.
