On November 2, 2010, the undersigned entered and mailed Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Final Order on Hearing, upholding the Insurance Commissioner's (OIC) revocation of the insurance agent/producer's license of Carlton Mark Williams. Said Final Order advised the Licensee that he could *seek reconsideration of this order by filing a request for reconsideration under RCW 34.05.470 with the undersigned within 10 days of the date of service (date of*

*mailing) of this order.* On November 12, 2010 the undersigned received an email copy of a letter Request for Reconsideration from the Licensee. As WAC 10-08-110(1)(c) prohibits email filings without prior permission of the presiding officer, the Licensee was advised to fax said Request. No fax was received, and on November 16, 2010 the Office of the Insurance Commissioner received the Licensee's Request for Reconsideration in hard copy. Although said Request for Reconsideration was filed 4 days late, the undersigned chose to accept the Request. At this time, the undersigned has reviewed and considered the Licensee's Request for Reconsideration in all respects as if it had been timely filed.

Pursuant to Title 48 RCW and particularly RCW 48.04, Title 34 RCW and particularly, for good cause shown, RCW 34.05.461(8), the undersigned has carefully reviewed the Licensee's Request for Reconsideration along with the entire hearing file and the transcript of the proceeding herein. The undersigned finds that there is no basis to change the Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Final Order on Hearing in any way.


This being the decision of the undersigned,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, while the Order of Revocation revoking the insurance agent/producer's license of Carlton Mark Williams was automatically stayed from February 11, 2010 (the effective date of revocation contained in the Insurance Commissioner's January 22, 2010 Order of Revocation) until November 22, 2010 (the effective date of the undersigned's Final Order upholding the Insurance Commissioner's revocation), the insurance agent/producer's license of Carlton Mark Williams has been revoked since November 22, 2010.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Licensee has provided no sufficient basis upon which the undersigned's Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Final Order on Proceeding herein should be changed in any way. Therefore, said Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Final Order on Proceeding shall remain unchanged and shall remain in effect indefinitely.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Carlton Mark Williams shall surrender his insurance agent/producer's license to the Office of the Insurance Commissioner, P.O. Box 40255, Olympia, Washington 98504-0255 or in person at 5000 Capitol Blvd., Tumwater, Washington 98502 by February 7, 2011.

The parties are advised that, pursuant to RCW 34.05.514 and 34.05.542, this order may be appealed to Superior Court by, within 30 days after date of service (date of mailing) of this order, 1) filing a petition in the Superior Court, at the petitioner's option, for (a) Thurston County or (b)

the county of the petitioner's residence or principal place of business; and 2) delivery of a copy of the petition to the Office of the Insurance Commissioner; and 3) depositing copies of the petition upon all other parties of record and the Office of the Attorney General in the United States mail. If a party chooses to file a petition in the Superior Court, he or she may, but is not required to, first file a request for reconsideration. For further information or to obtain copies of the applicable statutes, the parties may contact the administrative assistant to the undersigned.
