

STIPULATION AND ORDER

STIPULATION BY LICENSEE

Shirley A. Reardon, ("licensee") hereby stipulates to the payment of a fine in the amount of \$500.00 based on the following facts which are hereby acknowledged.

1. The Commissioner sent the licensee, to the address on file with the Office of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC), written inquiries on November 5, 2009, and December 16, 2009.
2. On January 20, 2010, a certified letter was mailed to the address on file with the OIC. The delivery receipt verifies that the certified letter was accepted and signed for.
3. These inquiries were related to the business of insurance requesting replacement fingerprint cards. The licensee did not respond to any of them. Each such failure to respond within fifteen business days violated RCW 48.17.475.
4. An order revoking the licensee's Washington insurance license was mailed on February 12, 2010 with an effective date of March 4, 2010.
5. The licensee contacted OIC March 8, 2010. As a result of this contact, an agreement was reached to provide the requested document and pay the fine.

The licensee has engaged in practices that are not in accord with the standards set out in the insurance code of Washington. Accordingly, the licensee enters this Stipulation to the following Order voluntarily and with the understanding that such fine is in lieu of the revocation of his insurance license for said conduct. The licensee further stipulates and agrees that he will promptly respond to future inquiries from the Commissioner, that a failure to respond within fifteen business days from receipt of an inquiry will be considered untimely and a violation of RCW 48.17.475, justifying revocation of the licensee's license.

STIPULATION AND ORDER

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ORDER

Pursuant to RCW 48.17.560 and the foregoing Stipulation, the Commissioner hereby imposes a fine in the amount of \$500.00 upon Shirley A. Reardon and hereby rescinds the Order Revoking License issued February 12, 2010 and effective March 4, 2010.

Since the licensee's license was cancelled effective (date), the licensee will apply for reinstatement of that license and pay all applicable fees.

Pursuant to RCW 48.17.475, the licensee shall respond to all future inquiries from the Commissioner no later than fifteen business days from receipt of an inquiry and a failure to respond within such time will be considered untimely and a violation of RCW 48.17.475 justifying revocation of the licensee's license..

The fine shall be paid in full within 30 days from the date of this Order. Upon failure to pay the fine, the Commissioner will withdraw this Stipulation and Order and the previous Order of Revocation will remain in effect.


