On March 1, 2010, the Office of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC) received a letter from Jason M. Briscoe (Licensee) in the matter of Jason M. Briscoe, Licensee, which letter was considered a Demand for Hearing. The purpose of said Demand for Hearing was to contest the OIC's February 12 Order Revoking License, No. 10-0031, which revoked the Licensee's nonresident insurance agent's license for failure to respond to three written inquiries from the OIC requesting replacement of fingerprint cards. Said Order bore an effective date of March 4, but was automatically stayed prior to its effective date. The Licensee asserted that he had sent new fingerprint cards on three separate occasions and all were denied. By request of the Licensee and agreement of the

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Insurance Commissioner, the undersigned delayed scheduling of the prehearing conference herein in order to provide the parties with additional time to negotiate a settlement.

On June 2, 2010, the parties executed a Stipulation and Order Levying a Fine, which required payment of a \$500.00 fine within 30 days from the date of said Order. On July 14, the Licensee notified Nicole Kelly, Paralegal to the undersigned, that he had chosen not to pay the fine or pursue his Demand for Hearing. Subsequently, on August 30, the Licensee filed a letter with the undersigned withdrawing his Demand for Hearing. The Licensee's letter of withdrawal is attached hereto and is by this reference made a part hereof. The Order Revoking License and all other documents referred to herein are included in the hearing file and are by this reference made a part hereof.

Based upon the above activity:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the proceeding in the matter of 10-0031 is dismissed with prejudice and the proceeding is terminated. The Order Revoking License No. 10-0031, issued by the Insurance Commissioner on February 12, 2010, is effective as of August 30, 2010 and shall remain in full force and effect.
