On April 30, 2010, the Office of Insurance Commissioner (OIC) entered an Order Revoking License, revoking the insurance producer's license of Lyle Glen Wallace asserting that Mr. Wallace failed to submit replacement fingerprint cards as those he originally submitted with his license had been returned to the OIC from law enforcement as illegible. Mr. Wallace appealed this Order Revoking License, asserting that he had not received the OIC's certified letter which the OIC had promised it would send to him containing new fingerprint cards for him to complete and return. On February 16, 2011, the undersigned entered Amended Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Final Order on Hearing. Said Amended Order set aside the OIC's Order Revoking License, which Order determined that based on the facts found therein Mr. Wallace's license should not be revoked provided that he submit the replacement fingerprint cards by March 3, 2011 or, in the alternative, submit a letter to the OIC that he no longer wishes to have an insurance producer's license in Washington.



ORDER CONFIRMING REVOCATION OF LICENSE

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
Based upon the OIC's Motion to Confirm dated March 7, 2011, supported by the attached Declaration of Jeff Baughman, the OIC's Licensing and Education Program Manager, the OIC asserts that Mr. Wallace failed to submit either the replacement fingerprint cards or a letter to the OIC advising he no longer wishes to have an insurance producer's license in Washington, as required by the undersigned's above Order entered February 16, 2011

Based upon the above activity, and in accordance with the undersigned's Amended Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Final Order entered February 16, 2011,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Insurance Commissioner's Order Revoking License entered April 30, 2010, revoking the insurance producer's license of Lyle Glen Wallace for failure to submit replacement fingerprint cards is UPHHELD;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Lyle Glen Wallace shall surrender his insurance producer's license to the Office of the Insurance Commissioner at the above address (and directed to Jeff Baughman, Licensing and Education Program Manager) within 10 days of the date of entry of this Order.

This Order is entered at Tumwater, Washington, this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2011, pursuant to RCW 34.05, Title 48 RCW and regulations applicable thereto.




