ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE
AND AMENDED NOTICE OF
PREHEARING CONFERENCE BY
TELEPHONE

Wage Payment

The above-referenced docket was scheduled for a Prehearing Conference before Administrative Law Judge Terry A. Schuh on Thursday, October 14, 2010 at 3:00 p.m. Charles Brown, staff attorney, appeared and represented the Office of the Insurance Commissioner. Melvin N. Sorenson and James E. Lobsenz of Carney Bradley Spellman, P.S., attorneys at law, appeared and represented the Respondent, Nation Motor Club, Inc. The Respondent moved for a more definite statement of the Insurance Commissioner's basis for intending to revoke the Respondent's registration. Mr. Brown agreed to provide a more definite statement no later than 5:00 p.m., October 25, 2010. Accordingly, the parties agreed to continue the prehearing conference to November 15, 2010, 3:00 p.m., as also noted below. The Administrative Law Judge granted the continuance.

By virtue of the authority contained in RCW 34.05.431 and WAC 10-08-130, a Prehearing Conference by telephone will be held before Administrative Law Judge Terry A. Schuh to address the following matters:

1. Simplification of issue for hearing;
2. Witnesses;
3. Documentary Evidence;
4. Stipulations;
5. Determination of hearing date and time, and mode (e.g., in-person or telephone hearing), and hearing length;
6. Any other issues appropriate for prehearing disposition.

The Prehearing Conference will be held on:

DATE: Monday, November 15, 2010

TIME: 3:00 P.M.

LOCATION: By Telephone

Instructions for Telephone Hearings: The prehearing conference will be conducted by telephone conference call. Please call ten (10) minutes prior to the above-scheduled time locally at (360) 753-7328 or toll free 1-800-843-7712. Calls from telephone booths, cell phones and cordless phones are discouraged as they are often not reliable for conducting conference calls. After the parties have called in, the Administrative Law Judge will call the parties back to begin the conference.

Failure to Appear: Parties who fail to attend or participate in a hearing or other stage of an adjudicative proceeding may be held in default in accordance with Chapter 34.05 RCW, RCW 34.05.440.

Postponements: If a party wishes to postpone the prehearing conference and on timely request shows good and sufficient cause, the Administrative Law Judge may order a continuance. To request another conference date, contact the Administrative Law Judge at the address or phone number listed below. All such requests must be reduced to writing.

Interpreters: If a limited English speaking or hearing impaired party or witness needs an interpreter, one will be provided at no cost. If a party needs an interpreter, the party should complete the attached interpreter request form and submit it to the Office of Administrative Hearings at the address indicated on the form.

Accommodation for Persons with Disabilities: If a party or a witness has a disability and desires accommodation by the Office of Administrative Hearings when using its facilities or services, the party should contact the Office of Administrative Hearings to address these needs at the telephone number listed above.

Additional Information: General information about the hearing process can be found on the Office of Administrative Hearings web site at www.oah.gov. Firearms and other dangerous weapons are prohibited at hearings and in all Office of Administrative Hearings offices, WAC 10-20-010. Additional reference can be made to Chapter 34.05 (Administrative Procedure Act) and Chapter 10-08 WAC (Model Rules of Procedure).

Scheduling of Hearing: A date for the hearing will be set at the prehearing conference.

Representation: A party may have an attorney or other qualified person at a prehearing conference.

Record: The prehearing conference will be digitally recorded.


