On November 19, 2010, the Insurance Commissioner ("OIC") received and filed a letter from Bryan H. Robinson via electronic mail ("e-mail"), which was considered to be a Demand for Hearing. The purpose of said Demand for Hearing was to contest the Commissioner's November 18, 2010 decision to deny his application for a Washington resident insurance producer's license pursuant to RCW 48.17.530(1)(h). Mr. Robinson asserted that his explanation of his situation would result in reversal of the OIC's decision, and asserted that the OIC's decision significantly impacted his earnings.

Pursuant to said Demand for Hearing, the first prehearing teleconference herein was scheduled to commence on January 13, 2011, and the parties agreed that the hearing should commence on January 21. Subsequently, the hearing date was continued to February 2 by

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
order of the undersigned based upon lack of adequate notice, and later continued to February 11 at the request of Mr. Robinson based upon reasonable objections concerning lack of specificity of the OIC's allegations against him.

On February 6, 2011, Mr. Robinson filed a withdrawal of his Demand for Hearing via e-mail with the express approval from the undersigned for email filing pursuant to WAC 10-08-110(c). (Mr. Robinson's second withdrawal of his Demand for Hearing was filed on February 15.) Mr. Robinson's e-mails withdrawing his Demand for Hearing are attached hereto. All documents relating to this adjudicative proceeding are included in the hearing file and are by this reference made a part hereof.

Based upon the above activity,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the adjudicative proceeding in the matter of Bryan H. Robinson, No. 10-0230, is terminated with prejudice. He may, however, apply again for an insurance producer's license at any time with a new right to appeal if the Office of Insurance Commissioner again denies his application.
