Hello, My name is Maria and I met you at my hearing April, 29th regarding my insurance agents license. My case was about my involvement with out of state drivers getting insurance and licenses in Washington. I realize that the circumstances of the case including my part in it are serious and I was wrong to have gotten involved. It really was not clear to me what was going on and looking back I really see how I was encouraged, manipulated and used. I was not really being very smart about this and along with my co-workers we kind of got caught up with this ring. There was no benefit for me to have written these policies other than I thought I was helping people and doing what my employer wanted me to do.

Since my hearing I had been in contact with one of my co-workers Francisco Murillo. It was encouraging to me when I found out that he had to pay a fine but was allowed to keep his license. Since we were equally involved I kind of expected the same penalty. Francisco was represented by an attorney and maybe that is what I should have done. The lessons I have learned from this have taught me many things including figuring out what is the right thing to do and my responsibility as a trusted licensed agent. What I have done reaches those people that need to trust me and my family with children. Because of my actions I have created a hardship emotionally and financially on them.

I guess what I am doing is reaching out to you to express my regret and to see if I can have another chance to make what I have done right. Please reconsider my revocation. I have an attorney lined up to help me with the appeal process and will do and follow whatever you feel I need to do.
