ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDINGS

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
On July 31, 2013, the Insurance Commissioner (OIC) issued a Disapproval Letter disapproving the filings submitted by Molina Healthcare of Washington, Inc. ("Molina") for its proposed participation in the individual market of the new Washington Health Benefit Exchange. On August 6, Timothy J. Parker of Carney Badley Spellman, Counsel for Molina filed a Demand for Hearing with the Hearings Unit on behalf of Molina, contesting the OIC's disapproval. On August 12, the undersigned received and filed an email letter sent on August 7 from Amy Dobberteen, Esq., in-house counsel with Molina, to AnnaLisa Gellermann, Deputy Commissioner for the OIC Legal Affairs Division, withdrawing Molina's August 6 Demand for Hearing.

Subsequently, on August 14, 2013 the undersigned held a prehearing conference to discuss the disposition of the proceedings. The OIC was represented by AnnaLisa Gellermann, Esq., Deputy Commissioner; Charles Brown, Senior Staff Attorney; and Andrea Philhower, Staff Attorney, all of the OIC's Legal Affairs Division. Molina was represented by Timothy J. Parker, Esq. At the prehearing conference, Mr. Parker confirmed that Molina was withdrawing its Demand for Hearing. The OIC agreed that it would not contest the issue should Molina file another Demand for Hearing relative to this filing in the future, and Molina recognized that any future Demand relative to this filing must be filed within ninety days of the date of the OIC's disapproval of Molina's filing. Finally, the parties agreed that there is no written agreement relating to Molina's withdrawal of the Demand for Hearing. Molina's statement withdrawing the request for hearing is attached hereto and is by this reference made a part hereof.

Based upon the above activity,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this proceeding, Docket No. 13-0234, is hereby dismissed.


