- 26 3. **KATE REYNOLDS**, Special Assistant to the Washington State Insurance
Commissioner in OIC's Policy and Legislation Division. Ms. Reynolds led the
rulemaking group responsible for updating Washington's administrative regulations on
network access. She may testify regarding the requirements of those rules as they
related to Exchange plans for 2014, as well as the requirements of the revised rules as
they relate to Exchange plans for 2015. She may testify to the Commissioner's policies
regarding innovation, competition, transparency, and consumer choice in the plans
offered on the Washington Health Benefit Exchange.

2 Protection. Ms. Childers may be called to testify regarding consumer complaints
3 related to Seattle Children's Hospital and complaints related to carriers' networks.


