On October 22, 2013, Seattle Children's Hospital ("SCH") filed a Demand for Hearing to contest the Insurance Commissioner's ("OIC") approvals of the individual market Exchange filings of Coordinated Care Corporation, Molina Healthcare of Washington, Inc., Premera Blue Cross and Bridgespan Health Company. Subsequently, following various other motions, on April 2, 2014 SCH filed a Motion to Set Hearing Date and Prehearing Schedule, and Protective Order. SCH's Motion was heard in prehearing conference on April 14, which included the OIC, SCH and the three Intervenors. During said prehearing conference, in aid of clarification of the issues to be addressed in this proceeding and in furtherance of discovery and scheduling a hearing date, SCH proposed and the OIC agreed that within 48 hours (by close of business on April 16) SCH would file and distribute its statement of the issues to be addressed in this adjudicative proceeding and proposed witness list, and within 48 hours (by close of business on April 18) the OIC would file and distribute its statement of the issues and proposed witness list. Both parties and the Intervenors agreed that, should Intervenors wish to file a statement of the issues and proposed witness list, then they would also do so by close of business on April 18. The parties agreed that the Intervenors' statement of the issues to be addressed and proposed witness list would be separate from the OIC's statement of the issues and proposed witness list. Finally, Intervenor Premera proposed, and it was agreed, that a second prehearing conference would commence on April 21 at 3:00 p.m. which shall include both parties and the Intervenors. The purpose of this second prehearing conference is to discuss the statements of the issues and proposed witness lists

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filed by the parties and the Intervenors in furtherance of clarification of the issues to be addressed in this proceeding, to discuss discovery governed by RCW 34.05.446 and by the Final Order on Petitions to Intervene Pursuant to RCW 34.05.443 entered herein on December 19, 2013, and to schedule a hearing date.

ORDER

On the basis of the foregoing activity,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SCH shall file its statement of the issues to be addressed in this proceeding, and proposed witness list, by close of business on April 16, 2014;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the OIC shall file its statement of the issues to be addressed in this proceeding, and proposed witness list, by close of business on April 18, 2014.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, should Intervenors wish to file a statement of the issues to be addressed in this proceeding, and proposed witness list, they shall do so by close of business on April 18, 2014. In recognition of the fact that Intervenors' interests are different from the OIC's interests, Intervenors' statement of the issues and proposed witness list shall be separate from the OIC's statement of the issues and proposed witness list.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a second prehearing conference shall be commenced on April 21, 2014 at 3:00 p.m. which shall include both parties and the Intervenors. The purpose of this second prehearing conference is to review and discuss the statements of the issues and proposed witness lists filed by the parties and the Intervenors in furtherance of clarification of the issues to be addressed at hearing, and in furtherance of discovery governed by RCW 34.05.446 and Final Order on Petitions to Intervene Pursuant to RCW 34.05.443, and to schedule a hearing date.

THIS ORDER IS ENTERED AT TUMWATER, WASHINGTON, this 15th day of April, 2014, pursuant to Title 48 RCW and specifically RCW 48.04; Title 34 RCW and regulations applicable thereto, and confirms that oral order of the undersigned which was entered on April 14, 2014 during prehearing conference which included both parties and the Intervenors.

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
