Insurance Commissioner's Motion for Reconsideration

Dear Counsel:

On August 19, 2014, the Hearings Unit received and filed the OIC's Motion for Reconsideration of the Order on Motion for Stay of Amended Cease and Desist Order filed on August 7, 2014.

RCW 34.05.470 provides in pertinent part:

- (1) *Within ten days of the service of a final order, any party may file a petition for reconsideration, ....*
- ...
- (3) *The agency is deemed to have denied the petition for reconsideration if, within twenty days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not either: (a) Dispose of the petition; or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition.*
- (4) *... The disposition shall be in the form of a written order denying the petition, granting the petition and dissolving or modifying the final order, or granting the petition and setting the matter for further hearing.*

By September 2, 2014, Benefit Marketing Solutions, LLC (BMS) and Benefit Services Association (BSA) shall serve and file their Response, if any, to the OIC's Motion. BMS and BSA are encouraged to provide with their Response documentation as to any protections provided to Washington State consumers by the CLIP policy, including but not limited to 1) declarations page and policy, 2) licensing of the CLIP insurer, 3) approval of the CLIP policy by the Oklahoma Insurance Commissioner, and 4) coverage under the policy for Washington consumers. (See, August 6, 2014, Order, at Para. 7.)


