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To Honorable Judge Finkle,

I am writing this request to rescind the revocation of my insurance licenses. As I mentioned to you last week, the revocation order was issued in October, but was mailed to my prior address and a non working email, even though I had updated all my information as I was required to do so. I was not aware that my license had been revoked until late November, and this was only because an associate had brought it to my attention, otherwise, I would not have known. I was under the impression that I was past the window to request a reversal until a hearing. It was not until I spoke with your assistant Kelly last week, she advised me that I could still request a reversal, but I would have to give an explanation as to why I did not request it immediately. I was not aware of these circumstances, that is why I did not make it sooner. I thought I could only request a hearing at this point. Although I am no longer practicing insurance, I have been laid off of my current position because of this revocation, and it is becoming very difficult to secure any type of employment. Yakima is a very small town and the people I filed a lawsuit against are very vindictive and have taken it upon themselves to call my former employer and potential employers to assure them that if they hired me, they would lose their business and that of their clients and friends. Judge Finkle, I can assure you that all the allegations made against me from State Farm were false and malicious, is was a turf war and their attempt to smear my name and make it impossible for me to transact business. They made it very clear to me when they told me that they had a "building full of lawyers" and could basically do and say whatever they wanted, which they did. Although they did agree to settle, I would have liked to take them to court to expose their lies and lack of integrity, but my resources could only take me so far, I can not compete with a fortune 500 company.

I know that it would be best to have an attorney, but at this point, I cannot afford one since I have lost my employment and have been unable to secure employment because this revocation continues comes up. I am asking you to consider reversing it until I can prove the allegations are false, it is making it impossible to provide for my family as we are in danger of losing our housing as well, I don't know what else I can do, I feel I did what I was supposed to in providing my contact information current, it was an error by OIC as the correspondence was not sent to me, please take this into consideration and I thank you for your time,
