(As Presiding Officer, I have not had prior involvement with this case.) All stages of the hearing process, including the PHC, are public, and interested persons may attend, upon request to the Hearings Unit.~~

Topics to be addressed at the PHC will include 1) the appropriate procedure for considering Respondents' request for stay; and 2) the appropriate forum for considering the merits of Respondents' Objection to the Order to Cease and Desist.
