

On June 3, 2015, the Hearings Unit received and filed an email from you, which I consider to be your Demand for Hearing to contest the Commissioner's Order Revoking License ("Order Revoking"), which revoked your Washington State insurance producer's license.

RCW 48.04.010(3) provides:

Unless a person aggrieved by a written order of the commissioner demands a hearing thereon within ninety days after receiving notice of such order, or in the case of a licensee under Title 48 RCW within ninety days after the commissioner has mailed the order to the licensee at the most recent address shown in the commissioner's licensing records for the licensee, the right to such hearing shall conclusively be deemed to have been waived. (Emphasis added.)

WAC 10-08-110(1)(a) provides:

Papers required to be filed with the agency shall be deemed filed upon actual receipt during office hours at any office of the agency.

The Order Revoking was effective March 16, 2015. The Certificate of Mailing attached to the Order states that on February 26, 2015, it was mailed to you at the addresses on file with the Office of the Insurance Commissioner ("OIC"), by both U.S. mail and email.

Under RCW 48.04.010(3), the deadline for filing your Demand for Hearing was May 27, 2015 (ninety days after February 26, 2015, when the commissioner mailed the Order Revoking to you at the most recent addresses shown in the commissioner's licensing records). Your Demand for Hearing was filed on June 3, 2015, after the deadline.

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However, in communications to the Hearings Unit, you state that you voluntarily surrendered your insurance producer's license approximately six months ago. If this is so, the deadline could be affected.

Order.

Ms. Gamble's right to a hearing to contest the Order Revoking is deemed conclusively waived under RCW 48.04.010(3), and such hearing will not be scheduled and this matter dismissed, *unless* by Thursday, June 25, 2015, Ms. Gamble provides evidence to the Hearings Unit (copy to Darryl Colman, OIC Insurance Enforcement Specialist) that she surrendered her license prior to the Order Revoking and/or that her Demand for Hearing met the deadline under RCW 48.04.010(3) and WAC 10-08-110(1)(a). If Ms. Gamble provides such evidence, I will schedule a telephonic Preliminary Hearing Conference and consider reinstating this matter.
