



3. On September 15, 2015, the OIC Hearings Unit transferred the Matter to the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") to be heard by an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), pursuant to RCW 48.04.010(5).
4. On September 30, 2015, OAH received a Withdrawal of Proposed Consent Order Levying Fine and Request for Order of Dismissal from OIC.
5. On October 5, 2015, OAH ALJ Terry A. Schuh entered an Initial Order Dismissing Appeal ("Initial Order"), on the basis that by withdrawing the proposed Consent Order, the OIC withdrew the subject matter of the Licensee's appeal and no issues remained for resolution by OAH.
6. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.464, ALJ Schuh's Initial Order was transmitted to me, as Reviewing Officer, for review and for entry of Final Order.
7. I have reviewed and considered the record in this Matter, including ALJ Schuh's Initial Order Dismissing Appeal.

**ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Initial Order Dismissing Appeal is affirmed. This matter is now dismissed with prejudice and the proceedings terminated.
