IT IS ORDERED AND YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that your Washington State nonresident insurance producer license is **REVOKED**, effective **October 23, 2015**, as authorized by RCW 48.17.530.

BASIS:

1. Elizabeth Azmitia ("the Licensee") has been licensed by the Insurance Commissioner as a nonresident insurance producer since February 2013.
2. The Licensee falsely informed the Insurance Commissioner that she resides in California, even though she has been a Washington resident since early 2013.
3. In November 2014, the Licensee went to a hospital where she misrepresented herself as a Washington Health Benefit Exchange employee and demanded the names of prospective insurance clients. In light of this and other unprofessional conduct, the Washington Health Benefit Exchange advised Azmitia that her unprofessional behavior must end immediately.
4. Between April and September 2015, the Insurance Commissioner sent the Licensee multiple inquiries regarding her conduct, which included requests for information and for her

participation in an investigative interview. The Licensee failed to timely respond to at least one inquiry, failed to fully respond to other inquiries, and refused to participate in an interview.

5. RCW 48.01.030 requires that all persons be actuated by good faith, abstain from deception, and practice honesty and equity in all insurance matters, while preserving inviolate the integrity of insurance. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.01.030, justifying the revocation of her license.

6. RCW 48.17.170(12) and WAC 284-17-005(2) require licensees to inform the Insurance Commissioner of a change of address within thirty days of the change. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.17.170(12) and WAC 284-17-005(2), justifying the revocation of her license.

7. RCW 48.17.475 requires licensees to reply in writing to an inquiry of the commissioner within fifteen business days from receipt of the inquiry. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.17.475, justifying the revocation of her license.

8. RCW 48.17.530(1)(a) allows the Insurance Commissioner to place on probation, suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.17.530(1)(a), justifying the revocation of her license.

9. RCW 48.17.530(1)(b) allows the Insurance Commissioner to place on probation, suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating any insurance laws, or violating any rule, subpoena, or order of the Insurance Commissioner or of another state's insurance commissioner. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.17.530(1)(b), justifying the revocation of her license.

10. RCW 48.17.530(1)(h) allows the Insurance Commissioner to place on probation, suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in this state or elsewhere. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.17.530(1)(h), justifying the revocation of her license.

11. RCW 48.30.040 prohibits knowingly making, publishing, or disseminating any false, deceptive or misleading representation or advertising in the conduct of the business of

insurance, or relative to the business of insurance or relative to any person engaged therein. By engaging in the conduct described above, the Licensee violated RCW 48.30.040, justifying the revocation of her license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you return your insurance producer license certificate to the Insurance Commissioner on or before the effective date of the revocation of your license, as required by RCW 48.17.530(4). Return your license to:

NOTICE OF YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING

If you are aggrieved by this Order Revoking License, you may demand a hearing in accordance with RCW 48.04.010, WAC 284-02-070 and WAC 10-08-110. Generally a hearing demand must be in writing and received within 90 days after the date of this Order Revoking License, which is the day it was mailed to you, or you will waive your right to a hearing.

If the Insurance Commissioner receives your demand for a hearing before the effective date listed on the order revoking your license, the revocation will be automatically stayed (postponed) and your license will remain in effect pending the hearing.

Your demand for a hearing should be sent to the following address and must briefly state how you are harmed by this decision and why you disagree with it:


