This is to advise you that on December 9, 2015, the Hearings Unit received and filed your Demand for Hearing.

Per your request and RCW 48.04.010(5), your Demand for Hearing will be transmitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) where an administrative law judge (ALJ) will be assigned to conduct prehearing activities and preside over the evidentiary hearing. The ALJ will schedule a prehearing conference to discuss this matter with all parties. Following the hearing before OAH, the ALJ will enter an Initial Order under RCW 34.05.461(1)(c), including findings of fact and conclusions of law, which will then be sent to me along with the hearing record for review and entry of a Final Order pursuant to RCW 34.05.464. However, should this matter be settled prior to hearing before the ALJ, or the Aggrieved Party fails to appear at scheduled hearing, the ALJ will issue a Final Order.
