ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDING
NO. D06-158 & D06-247
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On March 21, 2006, Gary Wyche, (Wyche) filed a request for hearing and that an initial or recommended decision be first entered by an administrative law judge from the Office of Administrative Hearings. Wyche's request for hearing objected to the Insurance Commissioner's (OIC) Order Revoking License, No. D06-158, and the alleged violations therein. On April 4, 2006, this matter was transferred to the Office of Administrative Hearings for an initial decision. Richard Hattenhauer, Esquire, represented Gary Wyche and the Insurance Commissioner appeared pro se by and through Kate White, Staff Attorney for Legal Affairs.

On September 11 and 14, 2006, Stipulation and Consent Order No. D06-247, incorporating the original Order Revoking License No. D06-158, resolving all the outstanding issues in this case, was executed by all of the parties. Copies of the Stipulation and Consent Order and Order of Dismissal are attached hereto and are by this reference incorporated herein.

STIPULATION AND CONSENT TO
ORDER

Order D06-247

Pursuant to RCW 34.05.060 and WAC 10.08.230(2) (b), the parties hereby stipulate to the entry of the following Stipulation and Order in resolution of this matter as follows:

STIPULATED FACTS AND LAW

1. Gary A. Wyche (hereinafter "Wyche" or "licensee") holds an insurance agent's license issued by the Office of the Insurance Commissioner (hereinafter "OIC").
2. The OIC entered an Order Revoking License No. D 06-158 on March 15, 2006 revoking Wyche's license. Pursuant to RCW 48.04.040, Wyche objected the OIC's order and requested an administrative hearing as a result of which, pursuant to RCW 48.04.020, the Order Revoking License was stayed and Wyche's insurance agent's license was not revoked.
3. The OIC based its Order Revoking License on the facts established by a Stipulation and Final Order in case no. INS 05-06-014 issued by the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services, Insurance Division on September 19, 2005 (hereinafter "Oregon Stipulation").
4. Because of the parties' agreement to enter into this Stipulation and Consent to Order, the OIC has not independently established the facts contained in the Oregon Stipulation.



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
STIPULATION AND CONSENT TO ORDER

Gary A. Wyche hereby stipulates to entry of the preceding Stipulated Facts and Law and to the following Order which may be entered forthwith and without further notice. Gary A. Wyche enters into this stipulation voluntarily and in lieu of OIC's request for revocation of his license for the conduct set forth above and in lieu of any further proceedings in OAH Docket Number 2006-INS-0004. Wyche acknowledges that if the conditions set forth in the Order are not fully met, the Insurance Commissioner may revoke his insurance agent's license pursuant to RCW 48.17.540(3).



STIPULATION AND CONSENT TO ORDER

OAH Docket No. 2006-INS-0004

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ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to RCW 48.17.530, and the foregoing Stipulated Facts and Law and Consent to Order that:

1. Voluntary Relinquishment of License. In lieu of the license revocation ordered in Order Revoking License, No. D 06-158 entered on March 15, 2006, which revocation is hereby withdrawn, Gary A. Wyche agrees to voluntarily relinquish his insurance agent's license. Wyche agrees to voluntarily return his insurance agent's license to the OIC at the same time he returns his signature on this Stipulation and Consent to Order.
2. Termination of Administrative Proceedings. Once the OIC has received the Stipulation and Consent to Order signed by Wyche and his counsel, accompanied by Wyche's insurance agent's license, the OIC will execute the Stipulation and Consent to Order and submit the same to Judge Gay at the Office of Administrative Hearings.
3. Future Conduct. After relinquishing his license, Wyche agrees not to engage in the insurance practices alleged in the Order of Revocation or in the business of insurance as set forth in the Insurance Code, RCW 48.
4. Application for New Agent's License. Wyche may reapply for an insurance agent's license from the Washington OIC at any time in the future under the following conditions:
 - a. Wyche's decision to voluntarily relinquish his agent's license shall not preclude any future application
 - b. In making any future application for a Washington agent's license, Wyche shall notify the OIC that the Oregon revocation occurred and provide evidence that the Oregon Stipulation has been reversed, set aside or rescinded.
5. Effect On Other Administrative Proceedings. This Consent to Order applies only to terminate the revocation in process as case no. INS 05-06-014 before the Office of Administrative Hearings. This Consent to Order does not affect any actions or investigations pending before any state regulatory agency other than the Office of the Insurance Commissioner. The Office of the Insurance Commissioner has continuing authority to enforce this Stipulation and Consent Order and to resolve disputes arising therefrom.


