On December 19, 2006, eHealthInsurance Services, Incorporated (eHealth), by and through Melvin N. Sorensen, Esq., of Carney Badley Spellman, 701 Fifth Avenue, #3600, Seattle, Washington, filed a Demand for Administrative Hearing and Review in the above captioned matter. eHealth's request objected to the Commissioner's (OIC)

Order to Cease and Desist, D06-261, entered on September 20, 2006. The OIC appeared pro se by and through Andrea L. Philhower, Staff Attorney in his Legal Affairs Division.

By letter dated April 5, 2007, eHealth advised that the matter has been resolved and that eHealthInsurance withdraws its Demand for Hearing. Subsequently, on April 9, 2007, an Initial Order of Dismissal/Appeal Withdrawal was entered by Todd Gay, Administrative Law Judge. The file was then forwarded to the undersigned to enter a Final Order. Specifically, as indicated in letter from the OIC dated April 3, 2007, eHealth has withdrawn the publication at issue and has explained to the OIC its procedures for verifying information for future publications, and the OIC has therefore determined that no further enforcement action is necessary to achieve the OIC's regulatory objectives. By letter dated April 5, 2007, eHealth advises that the matter has been resolved and that eHealth was withdrawing its Request for Hearing. Copies of these letters are attached hereto and are by this reference incorporated herein. The subject Order to Cease and Desist remains in full force and effect.


Dear Mr. Parker:
