
On April 18, 2006, Jefferson-Pilot Life Insurance Company (JPLIC) and its affiliates, by and through their attorney, Jerry Kindinger, of Ryan, Swanson & Cleveland of Seattle, filed a Demand for Administrative Hearing and Review dated April 13, 2006 requesting a hearing in the above captioned matter. JPLIC and its affiliates objected to the Insurance Commissioner's (OIC) March 29, 2006 Order Suspending Certificates of Authority in the above-referenced numbers, and sought review of this action. Marcia Stickler, Staff Attorney for Legal Affairs, appeared representing the OIC.

On May 4, 2006, JPLIC and its affiliates filed a letter dated April 25, 2006 advising that they had resolved the pending issues and were therefore withdrawing their request for hearing. Relative to the settlement of this matter, the OIC filed its executed Order Vacating Order Suspending Certificates of Authority Nunc Pro Tunc and are attached hereto and are by this reference incorporated herein. It is noted that 1) although the Order Vacating recites "Findings of Facts" and "Conclusions of Law," no adjudication has ever taken place herein. 2) It is further noted that a "nunc pro tunc" designation as stated on said Order Vacating has not been requested or authorized in this matter, is not appropriate in this situation and is of no effect.

Based upon the above activity:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-referenced proceedings, Docket No. D06-50 and D06-51 are terminated.

2. There is no basis for suspension of Jefferson Pilot Lifeamerica's Certificate of Authority, as the matter of the late 2004 filing has been resolved.
