Dear Mr. Hamje:

I have received the Order Revoking License (“Order”), effective July 5, 2007, and I am Aggrieved by it because it threatens my livelihood. Pursuant to RCW 48.04.010, I demand a hearing. I elect Option #2, a hearing presided over by an Administrative Law Judge assigned from the office of Administrative Hearings.

Briefly, I believe the Order should be changed for the following reasons. In regards to # 5 a. b. c. d. e. I disagree. I would like to address these in the hearing. At that time I will provide additional information.

I have **cooperated** with the OIC’s investigation of this matter, including answering Mr. Vic Overholts’s written questions and in person. I complied with all of Mr. Overholts requests and the department.

The fact that I have not addressed a particular allegation in this brief response does not mean that I concede the allegation. To the contrary, at the hearing I will be prepared to respond to each allegation made in the Order.

Revoking my insurance license is not the public interest. I am a good agent who cares for the customers with whom I work, and I take strong offense at the allegations made in the order, which I believe to be unjustified.

I look forward to answer future questions from the Administrative law Judge. Please provide me with the date, time and location of my hearing for option #2
