Julie D Lemery moves for entry of an order dismissing the OIC's Notice to Show Cause filed November 2, 2007 for the reason that the OIC discloses in their letter of November 29, 2007 that was delivered to the above addresses on January 11, 2007.


In that letter Mr. Charles D. Brown, OIC Staff Attorney, indicates that the OIC will attempt to use a lawsuit filed for a Lemery Insurance Agency LLC and July Lemery v. Farmers Insurance Group of Companies, King County Superior Court Cause No. 03-2-23809-1SEA.

I am not "July Lemery", nor have I ever owned, been partnered with or had any connection with "Lemery Insurance Agency LLC". I have at no time ever been sued by Farmers Insurance, nor have ever gone to court in any context having to do with Farmers Insurance.

I request an order that the OIC supply complete and true copies to me of all INS24 Termination of Appointment/Affiliation notices (copy of form attached) filed on my and my agency's licenses since their inception. The OIC RCWs and WACs consistently demand that all insurance agency records be kept a minimum of five years, while OIC applications for licenses are kept permanently, so Mr. Brown's "understanding" that those documents "retention period is 60 days" is not valid nor believable. Having copies of these documents would prevent any other assertions of wrongdoing against myself or my agency Main Street Insurance.

I further request an order dismissing all OIC requests to revoke any of my or my agency's licenses. Since the OIC apparently through it's letter of September 12, 2007 rescinded the letter of reprimand issued on May 30, 2007, there is no reason to have a hearing on February 13, 2008 so I request that it be dismissed and this entire proceeding be terminated.
