LICENSE AND DEMAND FOR
HEARING

John Hanley d/b/a Jurisco, through his counsel, Mike DeLeo of Eisenhower & Carlson, PLLC, hereby objects to the Order Revoking License dated August 15, 2008, and demands a hearing pursuant to RCW 48.04.020.

John Hanley d/b/a Jurisco states briefly why he believes the Order should be changed as follows. John Hanley d/b/a Jurisco believe that there is exculpatory information and documents that he intends to present that he believes will or should change the Order. The office of the Insurance Commissioner's audit covered a period of about three years. Consequently, there is a lot of information for counsel to review and present. As a result, John Hanley d/b/a Jurisco will amend and supplement this Objection and demand for a hearing as necessary as more information becomes available and as the Insurance Commissioner's office may request.

Pursuant to RCW 48.04.020 the revocation is stayed (postponed) pending the hearing.
