ORDER GRANTING 4-WEEK
SUSPENSION OF SCHEDULE;

NOTICE OF PREHEARING
CONFERENCE (May 29, 2009)

In The Matter of:

COMMONWEALTH LAND TITLE

Upon a showing of good cause, the Office of Administrative Hearings has granted an Indefinite Order of Continuance for the above-referenced docket numbers.

These three dockets present similar, if not identical questions of law, based upon differing allegations of fact.

The current schedules of record were established in October, 2008. They were continued for two weeks in early March, 2009, at the parties' request, to allow time for settlement negotiations that proved incapable of reaching resolution. In a March 10 Status Conference, the parties asked leave to negotiate an agreed schedule. They agreed that dockets 0004 and 0006 could proceed on a schedule parallel to the current schedule, but also agreed that docket 0005 requires an adjusted schedule.

However, instead of submitting an agreed schedule, the parties on March 18, 2009 filed a joint motion for an indefinite suspension of the schedule. They argue that a similar case is now

pending on review before the Insurance Commissioner upon which a decision is assertedly imminent. The parties argue that availability of the decision might enhance the prospect of settlements in the dockets here at issue.

The motion for an indefinite suspension of the schedule is denied. These matters have been pending for an extended period. They have been further delayed by failures relating to discovery and by procedural issues. While delays have been granted for necessary accommodation to the needs of litigation, further indefinite delay would interfere with the rights of the parties to a timely decision. If the parties desire an indefinite suspension of the proceeding, they may ask a voluntary dismissal of the dockets and re-file on these or similar claims when the time is right.

Instead, we grant a 4-week suspension of the schedules, in addition to the two-week extension of time earlier granted and used for settlement discussions. Because the parties indicated that the hearing in Docket 0005 might require additional time, the parties may provide support for a further schedule adjustment in that proceeding.

For the parties' reference, the resulting schedule as we calculate it is as follows (the schedule is the same in all three dockets, and all dates are in 2009):

NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE



The parties will be advised of hearing locations in Olympia.


