request for continuance was granted to the OIC, for good cause shown, and the hearing date was continued until November 8, 2005.


On Friday, November 4, 2005, a second request for continuance was made by the OIC. The OIC was represented by Deputy Commissioner Carol Sureau. Mr. Dome, Ms. Teraoka and Derek Wooley, Consultant, were present for the motion on behalf of TARCO. The basis for the motion was that both parties were in agreement to a settlement of this case, but additional time was necessary. Said motion was granted.

On January 6, 2006, the OIC filed an Order Rescinding Order G2005-08 Revoking Certificate of Authority No. 860 and filed an Order Suspending Certificate of Authority No. 860, which were both duly executed by both parties. Said Order Rescinding and Order Suspending, which for no apparent reason do bear a different cause number, No. G2005-90, are included in the hearing file and are by this reference incorporated herein.

Based upon the above activity,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this proceeding is terminated with prejudice.
