
On June 26, 2006, Great Republic Life Insurance Company (Great Republic), by and through its attorneys, Timothy J. Parker and Jason W. Anderson of Seattle, WA, filed a Request for Hearing in this matter pursuant to RCW 48.04.010 and 48.03.040(3). The purpose of said Request for Hearing was to request consideration of its objections to the Insurance Commissioner's (OIC) Proposed Report of the OIC dated June 8, 2006 on the Financial Examination of Great Republic Life Insurance Company as of December 31, 2004 (Financial Examination).

Accordingly, an adjudicative proceeding was scheduled to commence on April 9, 2007. Prior to the date for hearing, however, on April 2, 2007, Great Republic advised that the parties in the proceeding had resolved the issues in the matter and therefore it was withdrawing its Request for Hearing and requested that the matter be dismissed. Specifically, the parties had agreed on changes to the OIC's Financial Examination. Included in the hearing file, and by this reference incorporated herein, are 1) Great Republic's letter dated April 2, 2007 executed by Jason W. Anderson, Esq. representing Great Republic, advising that the matter had been settled and requesting that the proceeding be terminated; 2) the Financial Examination report Great Republic contested as the basis of this appeal; and 3) the new Financial Examination which contains the agreed upon changes.

Based upon the above activity:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, based upon settlement between the parties, the proceedings in this matter, No. G06-45, is hereby terminated.
