The purpose of this Amended Notice of Hearing is solely to correct the statutory references, as shown in the changes indicated below and the typographical error on page 2. Other than those changes, the original Notice of Hearing entered on September 16, 2008, remains effective in its entirety as of date of entry.

Capital Group Companies, Inc. (CGC) wholly owns various subsidiaries (CGC Management Companies) which conduct the business of investment management. The CGC Management Companies principally consist of Capital Research and Management Company, which provides investment management services to the American Funds family of mutual funds, and Capital Group International, Inc., which provide investment management services to institutional and high net worth investors. UnitedHealth Group, Inc., ("UNH") is a publicly held company that is the ultimate controlling person of PacifiCare of Washington, Inc., a Washington domiciled health care service contractor located in Seattle, Washington.

As of November 29, ~~2008~~, **2007**, UNH reported that it had 1,330,000,000 authorized shares of voting common stock issued and outstanding. As of November 29, 2007, mutual funds and clients managed by the CGC Management Companies held, collectively, 102,429,904 such shares, representing 7.07% of the voting common stock of UNH.

CGC Management Companies are considering the acquisition of additional common stock of UNH that may result in the mutual funds and accounts owning, in the aggregate, up to 20% of the authorized, issued and outstanding voting common stock of UNH, subject to the following conditions: Aggregate ownership of all clients of the CGC Management Companies will not exceed 20% of the authorized, issued and outstanding voting common stock of UNH, (2) no individual client (e.g. a mutual fund or any institutional or individual investor) of the CGC Management companies will own 10% or more of the authorized, issued and outstanding voting common stock of UNH. For this reason, in accordance with RCW ~~48.31B.015(5)~~, **48.31C.030(6)**, on January 9, 2008, CGC and CGC Management Companies, by and through James P. Ryan, Senior Vice President of Capital Group Companies, filed a Disclaimer of Affiliation and Control to acquire additional common stock of UnitedHealth Group, Inc. It is this Disclaimer of Affiliation and Control of UnitedHealth Group, the ultimate controlling person of the subsidiary, PacifiCare of Washington Inc., which is the subject of the adjudicative proceeding herein.

Based upon its assertions above, CGC and CGC Management Companies maintain that the clients of the CGC Management Companies will acquire UNH voting common stock solely for investment

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purposes.

~~Pursuant to RCW 48.31B.015(5), the Insurance Commissioner may by order exempt certain transactions from the statutory requirements otherwise pertaining to agreements to merge or consolidate with, or otherwise acquire control of, a domestic insurer. Specifically, pursuant to RCW 48.31B.015(5)(b), the Insurance Commissioner may by order exempt from the requirements of RCW 48.31B.015, 48.31C.030(6), an [offer, request, invitation, agreement, or other acquisition that the Insurance Commissioner determines as (i) Not having been made or entered into for the purpose and not having the effect of changing or influencing the control of a domestic insurer, or (ii) otherwise not comprehended within the purposes of this section.~~

Pursuant to 48.31C.030(6), Upon the request of a party to the acquisition the commissioner may order that this section does not apply to an offer, request, invitation, agreement, or acquisition as: (a) Not having been made or entered into for the purpose and not having the effect of changing or influencing the control of a domestic health carrier; or (b) Otherwise not comprehended within the purposes of this section.

Toward this end, the parties are advised that a duly authorized representative(s) of CGC, CGC Management Companies, and the Insurance Commissioner or his authorized representative, are expected to testify as to whether they believe that the statutory criteria for exemption under the above-referenced statute have been met.

While live testimony from the parties will be taken during the hearing as to the above identified issues, written declarations from those parties are also required to be submitted either before or during the hearing. Further, oral opening statements and oral closing arguments from CGC and CGC Management Companies are expected and a written closing argument is required to be filed either before or during the hearing. The parties must notify the undersigned one week prior to the hearing date should any witness request to testify by telephone.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that a hearing will be held commencing at 2 p.m., Pacific Standard Time, on Wednesday, October 1, 2008, in the Office of the Insurance Commissioner, 5000 Capitol Boulevard, Tumwater, Washington 98501, to consider the Disclaimer of Affiliation & Control of PacifiCare of Washington by CGC and Capital Management Companies.

The hearing will be held under the authority granted the Insurance Commissioner by Chapter 48.04 RCW and specifically RCW ~~48.31B.015(5)~~, **48.31C.030**, and shall have as its purpose consideration of CGC's and CGC Management Companies' request for an order exempting them from the ordinary statutory requirements pertaining to mergers, consolidations and other acquisitions of control of domestic insurers found in Chapter ~~48.31B~~ **48.31C** RCW relating to their proposed acquisition of up to 20% of the authorized, issued and outstanding voting common stock of UNH.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that all interested individuals and entities may submit comments on, or objections to, this proposed acquisition to the undersigned. Said comments or objections, which will be included in the hearing record and will be considered by the undersigned prior to her making her final decision, must be submitted by 5:00 p.m., Pacific

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Standard Time, on Tuesday, September 30, 2008, by fax, U.S. Mail, personal delivery, or email. The fax number of the undersigned is (360) 664-2782, her mailing address is PO Box 40255, Olympia, WA 98504-0255, her delivery address is 5000 Capitol Boulevard, Tumwater, Washington 98501, and the e-mail address for her paralegal is Wendyg@oic.wa.gov. Further, pursuant to RCW 48.31B.015(4)(b), 48.31C.030(4), any person whose interest is or might be affected may present evidence, examine and cross-examine witnesses, and offer oral and written arguments, and in connection therewith may conduct discovery proceedings as authorized by Title 34 RCW.

Finally, all parties may participate in the hearing. They may examine witnesses and fully respond and present evidence and argument on all issues involved, as required by the Administrative Procedure Act. The hearing will be governed by the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 34.05 RCW, and the model rules of procedure contained in Chapter 10-08 WAC. A party who fails to attend or participate in any stage of the proceeding may be held in default in accordance with Chapter 34.05 RCW.


