Section 1: April CE review & reminders



April CE overview

- MSP (SLMB) & LIS enrollment benefits.



Laura is 67 years old and lives in Pierce Co. She is currently enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan. Laura has received letters indicating her eligibility for the SLMB and LIS programs and her counselor Brian explained her new benefits.



Applies to both Part D (PDP) and Medicare Advantage (MAPD) plans:

- \$0 plan premium for benchmark PDP plans, reduced premiums for other plans.
- \$0 Part D deductible.
- Maximum co-pays of \$4.50 for generic and \$11.20 for brand-name drugs on plan formulary.



LIS/Extra Help information:

- Allows change of plan with Part D once per calendar quarter in the first three quarters of each year.
- Beneficiaries use Open Enrollment (October 15 – December 7) to choose Part D coverage for following year.



Section 2: Tools & rules





Dual-Eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNPs) are for beneficiaries with both Medicare and Medicaid.

Like all Medicare Advantage plans, D-SNPs are required to cover everything Original Medicare (Parts A & B) covers.

Benefits, providers, and drug formularies are designed to meet the specific needs of eligible groups.



Plans may charge a monthly premium.

Plans may set their own deductibles, copayments, and other cost-sharing for services.

Reminder: The SLMB program covers the Part B premium.



D-SNP providers

D-SNP plan options include:

- HMO
- PPO
- HMO-POS

Clients may pay more for out-of-network services.

Encourage clients to check with the plan before seeing an out-of-network provider.



All D-SNPs are required to provide Part D coverage and care coordination.

D-SNPs may offer additional benefits such as:

- Vision
 Dental
- Hearing Gym

Check with the plan directly to learn about coverage rules and restrictions for any added benefits.
