RE: Renewing your direct patient-provider primary health care services registration

It is time to renew your direct patient-provider primary health care services registration with the Office of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC).

You are currently registered as a provider offering direct patient-provider primary health care services in Washington. In order to continue to offer these services, Chapter 48.150 RCW requires you to **renew** your registration by submitting the annual registration statement.

You must complete your registration statement by **11:59 p.m. on Thursday, October 1, 2020**. Please use the following link to complete your renewal:

The renewal statement must be completed in order for you to continue offering direct patient-provider primary health care services. Your registration **will not** be renewed if you do not submit your completed statement timely and you cannot lawfully offer direct patient-provider primary health care services until you renew your registration with the OIC. If you continue to offer direct patient-provider primary health care services without being registered, you will be in violation of Washington law and subject to enforcement, including but not limited, to a Cease and Desist and a fine for transacting insurance without a license.
