Subject of possible rule making: Implementation of SSB 5419, Fire loss reporting

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 48.02.060; Chapter 225, Laws of 2025

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: This rule will implement Substitute Senate Bill 5419, which requires insurers to report fire losses to the OIC instead of to the Washington State Patrol. The Commissioner is considering rulemaking to assist insurance companies with fire loss data reporting requirements.
