This Notice is provided pursuant to RCW 48.04.010 and RCW 34.05.434.

Charles D. Oliver and American Equity Advisory Group, LLC (collectively, "Oliver") submitted a Demand for Hearing ("Demand"), filed December 3, 2014, requesting removal of a blog post of the Office of Insurance Commissioner's ("OIC") related to an Order to Cease and Desist ("C&D Order") issued against Oliver.

Oliver asserts in the Demand: 1) the blog contains false statements; 2) the C&D Order has been superseded by an agreement between Oliver and the OIC, and the blog post contains a dead link to the superseded C&D Order; 3) maintaining the blog is an *ultra vires* action by the OIC; 4) the C&D Order was false at the time it was issued without an opportunity for prior response or rebuttal; 5) the blog post is causing out-of-state individuals to cease doing business with or refrain from doing business with Oliver; 6) the blog post has been picked up by out-of-state individuals who now rely on it to falsely disparage Oliver, thereby causing business harm; 7) the blog does not serve any legitimate purpose of the state of Washington or its citizens, but instead is being used to further punish Oliver.

In the Demand, Oliver seeks removal of the blog post from the OIC website and damages for commercial disparagement. To the extent the Hearings Unit does not have authority or jurisdiction to provide the requested relief, Oliver states that he will pursue remedies in Thurston County Superior Court.

On January 6, 2015, the undersigned held a first prehearing conference. The OIC was represented by Assistant Attorney General Marta DeLeon. Gulliver Swenson, Attorney at Law, represented Oliver.

During the prehearing conference, the parties agreed that no legal authority supports the award of financial damages in this forum. In response to my invitation to the parties to state their positions on my authority to grant Oliver's remaining requested relief, the OIC filed a letter dated January 13, 2015; Oliver did not file a statement.

The OIC states in its letter that its understanding is that Oliver's presently requested relief is an order requiring that a blog post of the Commissioner be removed from the internet, not deleted, and that the OIC agrees that I have the authority to issue such relief. The OIC requested that I establish a briefing schedule for dispositive motions.

After considering the views of the Parties, I enter the following Order:

By February 6, 2015, the parties shall serve and file dispositive Motions, if any. By February 20, 2015, the parties shall serve and file Responses to such Motions. By February 27, 2015, the parties shall serve and file Replies to such Responses. (The parties may agree to adjust this schedule, informing me of such agreement, as long as the Reply brief is served and filed no later than March 6, 2015.) I expect to rule without oral argument as soon as possible after briefing is complete.

A hearing will be held at the Office of the Insurance Commissioner, 5000 Capitol Blvd., Tumwater, WA, beginning on March 24, 2015, at 10:00 AM, Pacific Daylight Time. The hearing is expected to require one day, but will continue until completed. The purpose of the hearing is to consider whether OIC should remove the blog post from the internet.

The hearing will be governed by the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 34.05 RCW, and the model rules of procedure contained in Chapter 10-08 WAC. All parties may be represented and may examine witnesses, respond, and present evidence and argument on all relevant issues.

A party who fails to attend or participate in the hearing or another stage of this proceeding may be held in default in accordance with Chapter 34.05 RCW. *See*, RCW 34.05.434(2)(i).

Judge George Finkle (Ret.), Presiding Officer, has been designated by the Insurance Commissioner to hear and determine this matter. The hearing will be held under the authority granted by the Insurance Commissioner under Chapter 48.04 RCW.
